Our club has previously reported on the issues of the lower Myall river health, and the move to have dredging carried out in the Lower Myall shortcut on the eastern side of Corrie Island, which has been instigated and driven by the Myall River Action Group. Our club sent a significant representation to a public meeting recently held in Tea Gardens in support of the Myall River Action group's initiatives. The draft report document has been released and public submissions have been sought regarding the report by Great Lakes Council.

The myall River Action Group have prepared some submission letter samples which on be signed off by our club members and lodged with the council.

Although the letters will be of the same content, they will be accepted as individual submissions. It is in our club's best interest to maintain good river flows to have a healthy river access to the myalls, and hopefully the dredging will help stem the growing siltation problems now experienced further up in the river.
